Responsibilities

Reporting directly to the Auxiliary Programming Coordinator, the Staff will:

- Summer Camp hours: 7:30 am to 4:40 pm
- Assist with classroom learning engagements.
- Assist with preparing and implementing daily activities.
- Supervise children to ensure that all safety protocols are adhered to and that children are following established rules and behaving in a respectful and appropriate manner.
- Report any safety, or behavioral related issues to the Auxiliary Programming Coordinator.
- Maintain an organized, clean, and safe environment.
- Engage with children in a positive manner, including implementing appropriate guidance techniques in line with classroom expectations and Riverstone's guiding principles.
- Assure that all students are signed in upon arrival to Summer Camp and when picked up by parents, guardians, or caregivers.
- Supervise students both inside the classroom and outside.
- Engage with staff, parents, and community members in a positive manner.
- Perform other duties as assigned.
